BOD Biography:

Dick Bradley

At eleven years old my first train was an American Flyer HO freight set purchased at a household sale in 1944. In college I joined the Tech Model Railroad Club and, as required for membership, joined the NMRA. After graduation, work at the Burroughs Research Laboratory put me in the Philadelphia area where I was involved in local model railroad clubs and the Mid Eastern Region of the NMRA. I was one of the founders of the MER Philadelphia Division. During this time J. H. Geissel introduced me to the Maryland & Pennsylvania RR, which has remained my

favorite prototype. I earned my Master Model Railroader certificate (No. 37) in 1972. I established the Yocolu Hobby Shop in 1972 and served model railroaders from behind the counter for 23 years, retiring in 1995. In the early seventies I was a founding member of the Alleghany Highlands Division of the NFR.

I am still active in local and NMRA activities. Participation in NMRA national, regional and division activities has brought me good friends and much pleasure. Over the years I have published over 40 articles in national model railroading magazines. At age 84 I am modeling the Ma & Pa in HO.
