



# Quick and Dirty Weathering with Oils

- Easy
  - Fast
  - Controllable
  - Reversible
  - Easy Setup
  - Easy Cleanup
  - Foundation for other Techniques
  - "Fleet" cars

# Materials

- Odorless turpenoid
- Flat soft brushes
- Pointed brushes
- Pipettes
- Metal palette
- Oil paints
- Flat camo brown
- DullCoat
- Hairdryer
- Paper towels / Shop Rags

# Technique


- Dab of oil paint on palette
- Mix with turpenoid
- Apply to car side
  - Start at roof edge
  - Pull straight down along car side
  - Avoid puddling
  - Work as desired
    - Dab brush on towels, suck up excess turpenoid
    - Add more paint into crevices, etc.
- Dry with hairdryer
- Can keep working until sealed with DullCoat

# Technique

- Pin Wash
  - Small pointed brush
  - Load with paint / turpenoid
  - Touch to crevice / detail / etc.
  - Let capillary action draw into detail
  - Air dry or hairdryer
  - Clean up with clean turpenoid on microbrush / q-tip



# Clean Up

- Clean brushes with fresh turpenoid
  - Soap and warm water
  - Wipe palette with shop rags
  - Soap and water
